Resident Complaint	Possible Ventilation or Building Construction Source
Odors from neighbors cooking	Poor air sealing between units
Odor from neighbor smoking	No weatherstipping on apartment corridor doors
	Central roof exhaust fan not well sealed to roof
Odor from corridors	Kitchen / Bath grilles and ventilation ductwork clogged with dust and grease.
Noise on top floors	Gaps between sheetrock/plaster and ductwork at kitchen/bath grilles
Noise from neighbors	Exhaust shaft leakage
Noisy bath fan	Kitchen / Bath exhaust fans pulling too much air in certain apartments
Mold on ceiling in bathroom	Kitchen / Bath exhaust fans not pulling enough air in certain apartments
Peeling paint in kitchen	Clocks/timers used to turn on/off central roof fan exhaust system – off at night
Peeling paint in bathroom	Bath/kitchen fan doesn't work well.
Resident Health Problems: Breathing issues like asthma,	Broken/loose belts in central exhaust fans pulling from bathrooms and/or kitchen or excessive fan vibration with oversized fan
headaches	Holes in walls near warm boiler room
	Kitchen fan does not exhaust to exterior
	Filter on forced hot air system <merv 8<="" td=""></merv>
	Apartment make-up air drawn from polluted spaces (truck entry; basements; etc)
