Justifications

Lead Poisoning Prevention Program – Increased funding to this program would allow for surveillance grants to all 50 states.

Asthma Control Program – Increased funding to this program would allow for increased and additional funding for state grants.

Environmental and Health Outcome Tracking Network – A \$6 million increase would fund at least three additional states and should be viewed as a down payment on funding all 50 and DC.
