

# LEAD SAFE Cleaning Tips

- Always **wash child's hands** before eating and napping.
- Use wet disposable wipes or wet paper towels to **collect paint chips before cleaning**. Bag and throw out used cleaning wipes.
- **Wet wipe surfaces** and damp mop often, including windowsills.
- **Flush all used cleaning water down the toilet.**
- **Wash your child's toys, teething toys, and pacifiers** in soapy water, rinse and air dry.
- **Only use a HEPA-filtered vacuum cleaner.**
- **Use a doormat** and take your shoes off at the door to avoid tracking lead dust into your home.
- **Do not bring lead home from work.** Keep and wash work clothes separately.

# BE LEAD SAFE Outside

- **Soil closest to your home or garage may be contaminated by lead paint.** Keep children away from any bare soil in the yard. Cover bare spots with 4-6 inches of mulch.
- Learn how to plant a raised garden or container garden to **avoid planting in lead-contaminated soil.** Children can safely help in these types of gardens.
- **Wear gloves** and wash up after gardening.
- **Porches are a common place to find lead paint.** Find other places for your children to play.
- **Wash** all your fresh vegetables, fruits, and herbs **before eating.**
